Minutes of the Mud Gran Prix
Thursday, 20 June, 1991 6:15 PM

Far behind, Richard, Del, and Steve swapped second place countless times, laughing with glee whenever the leader would flag the slick spots by sliding off the trail. Carol Bradford and Elaine Paul finished together, the first women. Erik Scharffenberg and Aaron Wheeler-Kay watched the clock and the cookie jar.
