Welcome to old runners and new runners! Welcome back to Eddie Zawaski, whose report of the winter solstice edition of the Polish Mud Grand Prix is appended. Eddie had run the US course the day before, but came to support the runners in the company of Sabin, who although not quite 14 months old, appreciated the sunshine, the mud, the company, and the cookies at least as much as his elders.

On race day, the temperature was mild; the trails were muddy. A big tree was down on Dogwood. The race didn't start on time, and some times may be approximate; as race director and runner, I remember doing better and remain guardedly optimistic about improvement.

A record number of participants had schedule conflicts. Running the course at your own convenience is an option that is discretionary, depending on the race director, and the current leadership is entirely open to the idea. Some runners were absent this time because of supporting or running Fred Willet's Pacific Rim One Day race, including Wild Bill McCracken, who now has the dubious distinction of having participated in three races in three days, including a one-day run. (Ask him for details.) Red Fisher ran a fast 50 K in Longview, and then stayed up all night helping. Erik aided Del to a fourth-place total 107 miles.

## ATTENDANCE

How many people usually run the Mud Grand Prix? Is it growing or fading in popularity? Do runners prefer a particular season for this race? Let us examine these seminal questions.

A total of 1518 finishers are listed for the 68 races for which documentation exists. (The results of four races are missing.) The overall average is thus just under two dozen participants.

The highest number of runners in one race was in 1978, when forty-six people ran the race; the fewest number of finishers was six. All three runs with fewer than ten finishers were in 1985.

A careful examination of these statistics shows the races are better-attended now than they were ten years ago, but not quite as popular as at their inauguration.

The results of an examination of the best attendance seasonally show that equinoxes beat solstices decisively, with the winter solstice run drawing the most participants. Perhaps people are making resolutions a couple of weeks early, or fulfilling them fifty weeks late. Possibly they simply prefer running in inclement weather. Maybe it's not as much fun if you cannot complain that it's too cold, too hot, or too muddy!
